

Thatelberoult Tountry Park



Chatelherault Country Park, a five star visitor attraction under the VisitScotland grading scheme, was once described as a Jewel in the Landscape. Chatelherault was built in 1732 as the hunting lodge and summer house for the Dukes of Hamilton. Designed by the famous Scottish Architect William Adam, whose son later designed Culzean Castle, Chatelherault now serves as the magnificent gateway to the Country Park. The restored buildings house the visitor centre, exhibition gallery, displays, gift shop, cafe and reception desk.

Visitors can view the Duke's private Banqueting Room and apartments and the formal gardens. In addition, Chatelherault serves as one of the country's most prestigious venues for weddings, functions and conferences. Outside, visitors can ramble through 10 miles of walks along the scenic River Avon and through ancient woodland.
