Lanark Memorial Hall

Lanark Memorial Hall is a Grade B listed building constructed in 1926 in memory of the 232 men belonging to Lanark and District who lost their lives in World War One. Lanark Memorial Hall has undergone a £6 million refurbishment with the support of the National Lottery Heritage Fund and Historic Scotland and is now a centre for cultural activities, the arts, weddings and functions.

Venue

The venue is fully licenced for alcohol, entertainment and wedding ceremonies, making it the perfect venue for your special day. Our in house catering team will offer a full range of menu options and packages.

After the ceremony, your guests are taken to the bar area for a drinks reception while you get your photographs taken.

The cutting of the wedding cake will take place before dinner.

Evening guests arrive and are shown to the Glenburnie Mezzanine until your meal has finished.
